



FELINE CONTROL COUNCIL OF QUEENSLAND INC. VACCINATION POLICY

All Show Officials, Judges, Stewards, Exhibitors, Breeders and the Public are asked to note the Feline Control Council of Queensland Inc. Vaccination Policy below;

Please note that in line with Queensland's Public Health and Social Measures, from 17 December 2021 only fully COVID-19 vaccinated show officials, judges, stewards, exhibitors, breeders and members of the public will be permitted to enter or attend any Feline Control Council of Queensland Inc. event or show. For the purposes of Queensland's Public Health Measures linked to vaccination status – a plan for 80% and beyond, a person is considered fully vaccinated when they have had two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine recognised by the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA). A person is not required to give their contact information, proof of vaccination or evidence of exemption from vaccination on genuine medical grounds if they are under the age of 16 years.

- ✔ I agree to check-in via the State Government 'Check In Qld' App every time I enter or re-enter any Feline Control Council of Queensland Inc Events or Shows.
- ✔ I note the provisions above in regards to being fully vaccinated against COVID-19 to enter any Feline Control Council of Queensland Inc Events or Shows and confirm that I am fully vaccinated or I have an exemption from vaccination on genuine medical grounds.
- ✔ I note the provisions above in regards to being fully vaccinated against COVID-19 to enter any Feline Control Council of Queensland Inc Events or Shows and confirm that anyone that accompanies me to any Feline Control Council of Queensland Inc event or show is fully vaccinated or has exemption from vaccination on genuine medical grounds and will also check-in via the State Government 'Check In Qld App every time they enter any Feline Control Council of Queensland Inc. Event or Show.
- ✔ I note that by entering any Feline Control Council of Queensland Inc Event or Show, I accept checks may be conducted throughout the Event to verify my COVID-19 vaccination status.

Please read carefully points below;

1. At any event or show, all attendees 16 years and over will be required to provide proof of vaccination or evidence of medical exemption, see boxes below;

There are 3 different types of proof available that you can get for free:

1. 1a COVID-19 digital certificate
2. immunisation history statement (IHS)
3. an International COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate for overseas travel

The COVID-19 vaccination certificate can be viewed or printed through:

- ✔ Medicare Online via MyGov
- ✔ Express Plus Medicare mobile app
- ✔ My Health Record

The persons who are exempted from getting a COVID-19 vaccination include those who have medical contraindications.

A person who cannot be vaccinated must show an evidence of contraindication. This is a medical certificate stating that a person is exempted from getting a COVID-19 vaccination. This can be downloaded from the Australian Immunisation Register.

A legally qualified medical practitioner is required to complete the medical exemption form and record this on the Australian Immunisation Register.

A person that has evidence of a medical contraindication will be treated as if they are fully vaccinated and may be permitted to enter and remain in business venues with eased restrictions for fully vaccinated people.

2. Anyone trying to gain access to an event or show who is not fully vaccinated or who does not have evidence of a medical exemption will be asked to leave. If anyone refuses to leave or becomes abusive at all, their name will be noted for further action and the Police may be called. Aggressive and abusive behaviour will not be tolerated;
3. At all shows we will tick off attendees who will then have their wrist stamped for exhibitors based upon those who have entered via 'Cat Shows Online. We will have blank ones available for extra attendees.
4. We will ask that everyone respects those checking. If they ask to verify your Vaccination status, they are only doing their job and taking reasonable steps to enforce the restrictions;

Attendees are asked to be patient and respectful to our Volunteers at all times.
